Introduction and Welcome



What is a TDP?

- Transportation Development Plan
- Identify needs, set priorities, and guide improvements and service development across a five- to ten-year period
- Balances needs with available resources
- Ensures programs/services reflect the community's mobility priorities

What is a TDP?

- Updated every five to ten years or as conditions warrant
- Includes a variety of public involvement activities, analysis of how each route is performing, and a review of residential and commercial development (recent and planned)

What is a TDP?

- Presents a “menu” of recommendations based on community feedback, stakeholder input, and consultant experience
- From these, a “preferred scenario” is crafted

What is a TDP?

- A “roadmap” guiding future decisions including:
 - Finance and capital expenditures
 - Policies
 - Changes to existing services
 - New routes
 - New programs/services

2018 TDP goals

1. Evaluate service needs throughout the Santa Clarita Valley and adjoining areas
2. Evaluate service needs in recently annexed areas, planned annexations, and new developments
3. Develop a service program on pace with economic, employment, and population projections



Visioning

- What should public transportation in the Santa Clarita Valley look like in the next five to ten years?
- What aspects or features of the City's current transit system are most important to you?
- How should public transportation programs/services develop?
- What specialized transportation services are needed?
- How should new residential and commercial developments be served?
- How should our local transit system fit into the regional transportation network?

What are your priorities?

- Service frequency
- Geographic coverage
- One-seat trip vs. transfers
- Sustainability
- Cost/fare
- Bus stop amenities
- Transit centers
- Local fixed-route bus
- Commuter bus
- Dial-A-Ride
- Supplemental school day services
- Special services (e.g., Beach Bus)
- Different service delivery methods
